

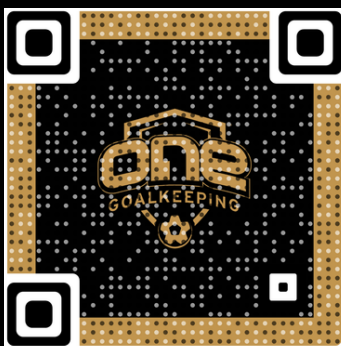

Jerrad is one of Queensland's best goalkeeper products having achieved success across a professional playing career spanning 18 years.

Enjoying spells in the A-League with clubs including Gold Coast United, Western Sydney Wanderers, Perth Glory and Melbourne Victory, Jerrad also spent time playing abroad in both Hong Kong and India.

An Australian youth international at U20 and U23 levels, Jerrad turned his attention to coaching in 2022 and launched the ONE Goalkeeping Academy. This now operates across multiple locations in the Sunshine Coast and Brisbane and provides further development opportunities to the next generation of aspiring goalkeepers.



The Tour



This 11-night tour will run from Friday 7 to Tuesday 18 January 2028 with a staffed flight departing Brisbane on Thursday 6 and returning home on Wednesday 19 (flight cost not included). The tour is available to dedicated goalkeepers of all abilities from 10-years-old, as well as family, spectators and football enthusiasts.

Specifically designed for goalkeepers, all training sessions, presentations and inclusions will be goalkeeper focused.

Tour Highlights

Watch Premier League, Women's Super League, FA or League Cup games (draw dependant).

Visit the home of English football, St. George's Park and engage in professional goalkeeper training sessions with a host of professional coaches.

Visit stadiums for behind the scenes tours such as Tottenham, Manchester City and Liverpool in 2026.

Sightseeing opportunities are up to you with experiences including the Albert Dock, The Beatles Museum or some retail therapy in the Trafford Centre in the North-West.

Major sites such as Big Ben, the London Eye and Buckingham Palace are all available in London.





Participation

Goalkeepers must be 10-years old to participate in sessions.

Goalkeepers under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian on the tour.

The 2026 Itinerary



(Delivered Jan 2-14 2026)

DAY 1

Jan 2nd

Arrive at London, Heathrow Airport and transfer to St George's Park (SGP).
Complete an afternoon recovery session with the SGP sport science team.

DAY 2

Jan 3rd

A morning of relaxation and touring the SGP facility.
EPL Fixture: Wolverhampton v West Ham

DAY 3

Jan 4th

Transfer to North-West England via a stop in Manchester to train at **Manchester City** and enjoy
EPL Fixture: Manchester City v Chelsea.

DAY 4

Jan 5th

A morning in Liverpool including a stadium tour at **Anfield** followed by an afternoon training session and development presentation with **Tranmere Rovers.**

DAY 5

Jan 6th

A day of rest and leisure in Liverpool to explore the city and its many historical sights.

DAY 6

Jan 7th

A morning master class with local professional coaches followed by a return to Manchester to tour City's **Etihad Stadium** and watch the **FA Cup fixture between Manchester City v Brighton.**

DAY 7

Jan 8th

Another morning masterclass with former Premier League goalkeeper coaches followed by a development presentation.

DAY 8

Jan 9th

Depart Liverpool and travel to Wales for a day in Wrexham. Visit the “**Racecourse**”, enjoy lunch at **The Turf** before completing a session with **Wrexham FC**. In the evening travel to London and check in to Stamford Bridge Hotel

DAY 9

Jan 10th

Today enjoy a rest day with the choice of either:
WSL Fixture: Arsenal v Man Utd at the Emirates
FA Cup Fixture: Fulham v Middlesbrough at Craven Cottage.

DAY 10

Jan 11th

Enjoy a training session at **Fulham** followed by back-to-back fixtures:

WSL: Chelsea v West Ham at Kings Meadow, and
FA Cup: West Ham v Queens Park Ranger at the London Stadium.

DAY 11

Jan 12th

A morning session at **Tottenham** before heading to the **Tottenham Stadium** for a stadium tour.

DAY 12

Jan 13th

A free day in London to visit famous locations and sight see. Dinner at the hotel to bring the tour to a close.

DAY 13

Jan 14th

Enjoy breakfast together before transferring back to London Heathrow Airport for the staffed flight home to Australia.

Tour Budget



The 2028 tour price has now been confirmed:

Goalkeepers: \$5,495.00

2026 tour apparel: approx. \$450.00 per goalkeeper

3. Once registered and conditions have been signed, you will receive a confirmation letter welcoming you to the tour.
4. Further information will continue to be provided over time including the fitting and ordering of travel and training gear.
